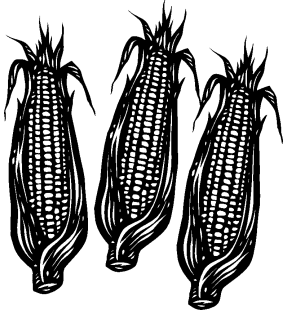
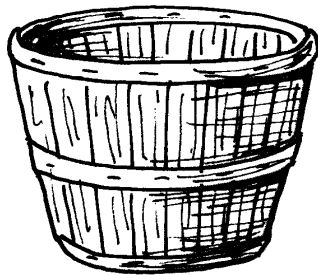
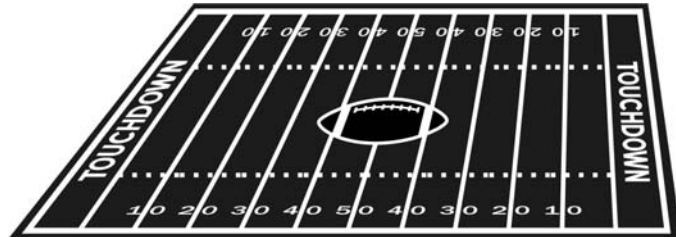


# What can we get from an acre of corn?



On average, an acre of farmland in DeKalb County produces nearly 200 bushels of corn.

One acre is about the size of a football field.



One bushel of corn weighs 56 pounds, or about the weight of an average 3<sup>rd</sup> grader.

One *bushel* of corn can produce:

32 pounds of starch

*or*

33 pounds of sweetener  
(enough to sweeten 413  
cans of soda pop!)

*or*

2.8 gallons of ethanol fuel  
*and*

17 pounds of livestock feed  
(distillers grain)

This means that we can get the following from one *acre* of DeKalb County corn:

6,400 pounds of starch

*or*

6,600 pounds of sweetener (enough to  
sweeten 82,600 cans of soda pop!)

*or*

560 gallons of ethanol fuel

*and*

3,400 pounds of livestock feed
